## Azam Uganda Premier League 2014-2015 Status

Following the communication of circular no.1004 and the emanating matters of concern raised by the FSLL and the UPL Clubs; the Status of the Azam Uganda Premier League (AUPL) 2014-2015 season was put on Agenda of the 7th FUFA Executive Committee meeting which sat at FUFA House on Wednesday 15th April 2015 and the following decisions were passed:-

The decision of the Emergency Committee to withdraw the mandate of FUFA Super League Limited (FSLL) to run the Elite Football League as provided for in the regulations for the 2014-15 Elite League Regulations was ratified and the status quo is to be maintained until the end of the current season.

The Executive Committee also decided that matters that are in contention be discussed after the current season ends to include all clubs that will be eligible to play in the season 2015-2016.

Executive Committee noted that all matters that are in contention should be handled and streamlined before the 2015- 2016 season starts so that the League runs smoothly throughout.

The Executive Committee mandated the UPL Secretariat headed by the CEO Mr. Bainamani Bernard and reporting directly to the FUFA Chief Executive Officer to undertake all matters of the AUPL until the end of the season.

In the meantime all Clubs, the FSLL, and stakeholders are encouraged to cooperate as the league is in a critical bend where managing football on the pitch in order to ensure fair play is the most paramount objective at the moment.
