FUFA Juniors League: New Regulations on points for Goals scored

FUFA has observed that one of the reasons players are not scoring as many goals is because the coaches and players change the tactics whenever one team leads by a goal margin.

It is therefore on this note that FUFA experiments a new regulation rewarding teams and players that attempt to score more goals even if they are already leading.

By this circular and in accordance with article 40 of the 2014/5 FUFA Competitions Regulations, FUFA hereby replaces article 14(4) of the 2014/5 FUFA Competitions Rules for the 2014/5 FUFA Juniors League with the following regulation; which starts with immediate effect.

The team that concedes more goal(s) than it has scored at the end of the match will be awarded zero (0) points

The team that concedes as many goal(s) as it has scored at the end of the match will be awarded one (1) point

The team that scores one (1) more goal than it has conceded at the end of the match will be awarded three (3) points

The team that scores two (2) or more goals than it has conceded at the end of the match will be awarded four (4) points

FUFA Believes that this regulation will improve on the attacking play of the teams
