CATEGORY 'A' NATIONAL SENIOR MEN'S TEAMS (UGANDA CRANES AND U23)

1. HEAD COACH

Reports To: FUFA Chief Executive Officer

Job Overview:

- Full time job
- Resident in Uganda during contract period
- Overall head of the National 'A' Men's senior team- The Uganda Cranes.
- Make all decisions related to technical or otherwise, during training sessions, games, also manage and instruct team members in an effort to win matches.
- Shall carry out necessary management and strategic planning of the National team
- To provide periodical reports to both the National Teams' Department and National Teams' Committee

Responsibilities and Duties:

- To manage the Senior Men's National team and the National U-23 men's team.
- Direct and organise training programs
- To respect and implement contractual obligations as shall be agreed on
- Maintaining records regarding National team performances
- Responsible for developing and/ or maintaining the National football philosophy
- To scout, monitor and select Ugandan players in the Domestic and foreign leagues.

Qualifications:

- Minimum requirement of a CAF - A License or other Confederations' equivalent
- Two years' experience of handling top flight African football at National Team or Club Continental Level
- IT proficiency
- Open to Ugandans and Non-Ugandans

2. ASSISTANT HEAD COACHES

Reports To: Head coach

Job Overview:

- Resident in Uganda during contract period
- Shall be assistant to the Head coach

- Act as the head in absence of the Head coach.
- Implement duties as assigned by the Head coach and FUFA

3. GOALKEEPER COACH

Reports To: Head coach

Job Overview:

- Responsible to train and uplift the quality of the Uganda Cranes and U-23 National team goalkeepers

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Responsible for delivery of the first team Goalkeepers' coaching programme
- Scouting and developing of individual goalkeepers within FUFA's programmes
- To conduct education programmes for Ugandan clubs' goalkeeper trainers

Qualifications:

- License in goalkeeping training
- IT proficiency is desirable
- Open to Ugandans and non-Ugandans

- Ensure the National team players are in good physical conditions to compete at all levels

Responsibilities and Duties:

- To provide support in strength, conditioning and sports science for the National team programmes
- Apply scientific principles and techniques with the aim of improving players' performance
- Providing information to the head coach on general physical fitness of the National team players

Qualifications:

- Experience working with a National team or top flight club
- Relevant academic qualification in Physical fitness education
- IT proficiency
- Open to Ugandans and Non Ugandans

5. TEAM COORDINATOR

Reports To: National Teams' Manager

Job Overview:

- Responsible for **ensuring National team** activities are effectively coordinated and requirements/logistics are in place.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Working with FUFA to ensure the National Team is managed in accordance with the existing National Teams' policies and Code of conduct.
- To monitor and ensure the National team complies with relevant Competition rules and various Government laws and regulations.
- Required to effectively plan and manage for the National team's off field activities

Qualifications:

- Should have played football.
- IT proficiency

6. VIDEO ANALYST

Reports To: Head coach

Job Overview:

- To provide National Team Performance Analysis for detailed pre and post-match meeting for direct use by the Head Coach, other coaching staff on the National team and FUFA.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Video capture and coding, both live and pre/post-match
- Organization and archiving of data/video.
- Take up special assignments as provided by the Head coach and FUFA
- Provide statistical data for all players eligible for the National team

Qualifications:

- Two year experience working in football video analysis
- IT proficiency

7. TEAM DOCTOR

Reports To: Head coach

Job Overview:

- Evaluate, monitor and assess the medical and health conditions of the players of the National team

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Ensure proper medical rehabilitation of injured players
- Recommend to the Head coach on measures to be undertaken to ensure the players' health is in good condition
- Ensure proper treatment is given to players within the acceptable medical guidelines
- Ensure compliance of National team and players to Competition Medical standards and guidelines
- Ensure the medical code of conduct is observed.

- Provide education and advice about exercises and movements of players
- Liaise with the Team Doctor and other Team medical personnel for better handling of players' physical exercises
- Help players recover from injuries using specialist and approved medical techniques
- To manage, assess and uplift the physiological conditions of players
- IT proficiency

- Qualified Medical Doctor (Minimum experience of 4yrs) with a bias in sports field
- Medical practicing License

9. KITS MAN

Reports To: Head Coach

Job Overview:

- Will be in charge of the National teams' kits and equipment.
- Liaise with the National teams office to have proper kits and equipment

Responsibilities and Duties:

- To manage the National team's kit requirements.

Job Overview:

- To plan, prepare and deliver coaching sessions in line with the FUFA Philosophy and coaching syllabus
- Overall head of the National Junior Teams
- To provide periodical reports to both the FUFA Development Directorate

Responsibilities and Duties:

- To manage the National Junior teams
- To maintain records regarding National Junior teams' and players performances
- To scout, monitor and select potential players for National Junior Teams

- CAF A Coaching License
- 5 year experience in coaching youth teams
- Resident in Uganda during contract period
