FUFA CLUB LICENSING SYSTEM; CRITERIA FOR FUFA WOMEN SUPER LEAGUE (FWSL) CLUBS TO BE ATTACHED TO MEN'S FOOTBALL CLUBS

The FUFA Executive Committee has decided that it shall be a mandatory requirement for obtaining the club license for the 2025/6 to be attached to an active men's football team in the Uganda Premier League or FUFA Big League or Regional League.

To fully comply with this requirement the license applicant (FWSL Club) may:

- a) Operate the men's team (s) itself; or
- b) Have a written understanding or agreement with another entity that operates the team (s).

The men's first team must take part in official competitions or programmes played at national, regional, any FUFA authorised competitions or programmes and recognised by FUFA.

In order to conform to these criteria, the license applicant will submit the following documents to the licensor decision making bodies, namely the First Instance Body (FIB) and the Appellant Body (AB) where applicable:

1. If applicable, a written agreement between the license applicant (FWSL Club) and another entity that operates the men's first team.
2. As a minimum, the agreement must include clauses with the names of the two parties, validity period (minimum of one (1) full season), general conditions, resources to be provided to the adopted team related to technical, financial, infrastructure, and other areas.
